### **Dr. Tom Lukens "Hero of Emergency Medicine"**

Congratulations Tom (93 Ohio) from your Heidelberg Beach neighbors!

*Press release from the ACEP:*

Cleveland Emergency Physician Thomas W. Lukens, MD, was recognized by The American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP) as "Hero of Emergency Medicine." The campaign is part of ACEP's 40th Anniversary and recognizes emergency physicians who have made significant contributions to emergency medicine, their communities, and their patients.

As a long-time board member and ACEP councilor representing Ohio ACEP, and as a member of several national ACEP committees and sections, Dr. Lukens has been able to contribute actively to the emergency medicine specialty. By working with the ACEP Clinical Policies Group, he has met with physicians from other countries to aid in developing their emergency medicine practice.

Dr. Lukens is an associate professor at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. He was among the founding faculty of the emergency medicine residency at MetroHealth in Cleveland, and has assisted in the teaching of more than 125 emergency medicine residents since that time. He became the first emergency medicine physician elected as medical staff president at MetroHealth, and later earned a promotion to associate professor at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. Along with several dedicated emergency medicine physicians in the

community, he co-founded the Northeast Ohio Society of Emergency Medicine, a forum focusing on common goals and education.

### **"Dr." Paul Rohrbaugh**



On May 12, Reverend Paul Rohrbaugh (59 Kentucky) was given an Honorary Doctor of Divinity from Heidelberg College. His father, Dr. Harry Rohrbaugh (builder of "The Pioneer") was also awarded the honor. Many members of the Rohrbaugh family were there to help celebrate.
